An update from ConectiSys CTO

We are thrilled to announce the completion of our back office application migration to Microsoft technology. One year ago the decision was made to move to a more suitable platform for our hosted back office application, to utilize new technology and tools to improve and extend the software more rapidly. According to studies, the use of Microsoft Visual Studio 2008 and Microsoft .NET Framework can save up to 50% or more in development and testing costs while improving performance and efficiency. The migration was planned in two parts; the software migration and redevelopment of the front end. Both parts have been completed.

Our back office system was developed in C# using the Microsoft .NET Framework and currently runs on Windows Server 2008, using Microsoft SQL Server 2008.

The use of SQL Server 2008 will lower administration and maintenance costs, while providing a high level of: performance, scalability, availability and functionality.

A Re-Cap of 2010

As 2010 began, the company had one focus in mind, to obtain a contract anywhere it could in the world. The company was in fact speaking with Union Fenosa (now Gas Natural Fenosa) for its demonstration at the time.
